JEAN ARNOT MEMORIAL FELLOWSHIP 2012

The annual Jean Arnot Memorial Fellowship honours Jean Fleming Arnot (1903–1995) MBE, FLAA, who had a distinguished career of 47 years in librarianship and was a pioneer of equal pay and women's rights.

The fellowship is awarded to a female librarian or student of librarianship for an outstanding paper of no more than 5000 words on any aspect of librarianship.

The paper should have been written within the last twelve months.

The paper should not have been previously published, but can have been delivered as a conference paper or seminar.

There is no mandated citation style: author's are advised to use that with which they are most comfortable.

A copy of the winning essay will be made available on the Library's website.

An award of \$1000 will be presented to the winner at the annual Jean Arnot Memorial Luncheon to be held on 4 May 2012, at Parliament House, Sydney.
