2024 NSW Premier's History Awards – Call for nominations

The State Library of NSW today [Wednesday 14 February] announced the opening of nominations for the NSW Premier's History Awards 2024.

A total of \$85,000 in prize money will be presented to the winners at an awards ceremony at the State Library on 6 September 2024.

Administered by the State Library, in association with Create NSW, the NSW Premier's History Awards will offer prizes in six categories this year:

- Australian History Prize (\$15,000)
- General History Prize (\$15,000)
- New South Wales Community and Regional History Prize (\$15,000)
- Young People's History Prize (\$15,000)
- Digital History Prize (\$15,000)
- The Anzac Memorial Trustees' Military History Prize (\$10,000)

All works nominated for the NSW Premier's History Awards 2024 must be first published, screened, broadcast or made publicly available between 1 April 2023 and 31 March 2024.

Nominations may be made by authors or by their authorised representative: agent, publisher, professional theatre company, film distributor, production company, or broadcasting company or corporation.
