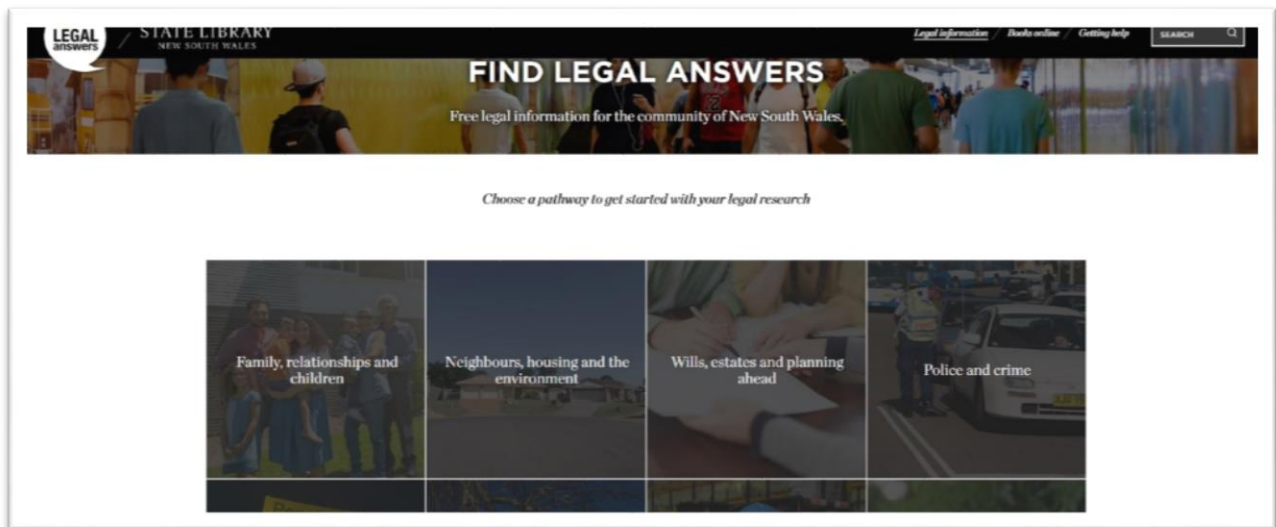


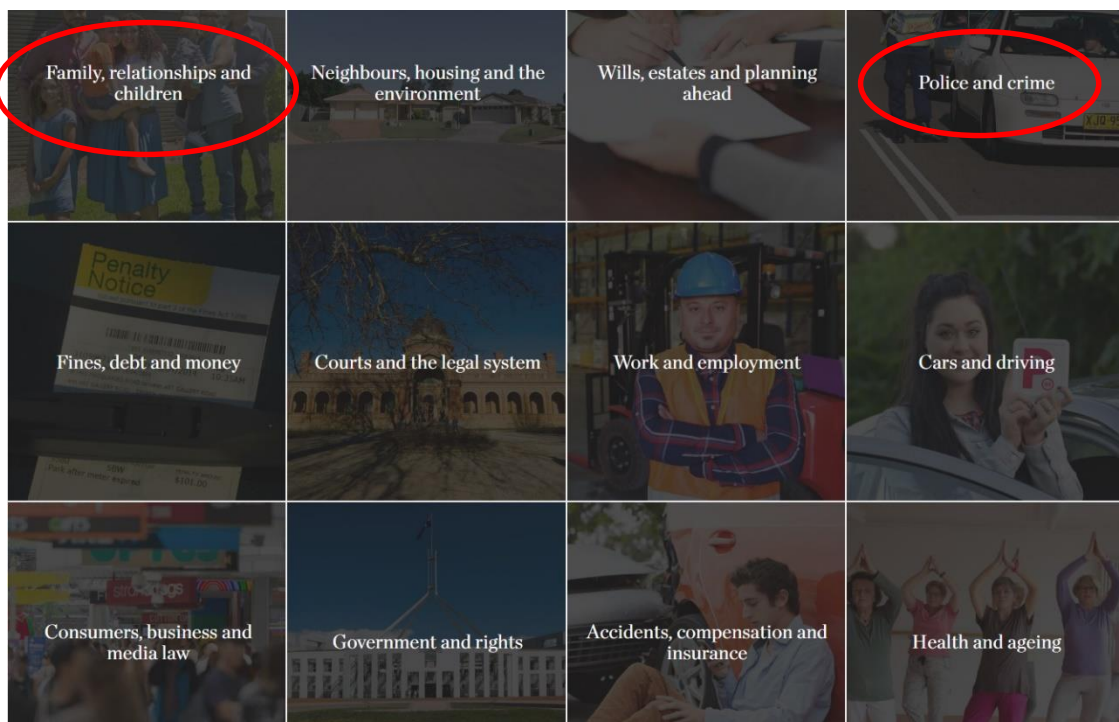

Under **Police and crime**, click on **AVOs**.



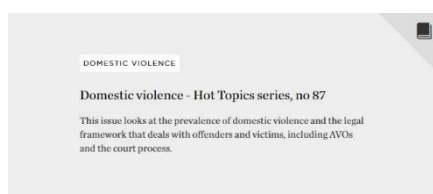

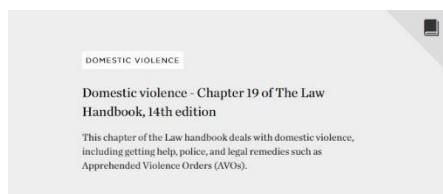

Domestic violence Hot Topic



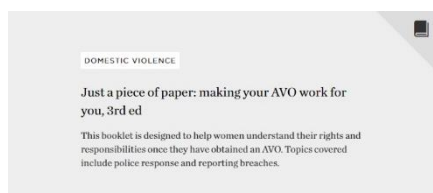
Looks at the prevalence of domestic violence and the legal framework that deals with offenders and victims, including AVOs and the court process.
