
## Representation

**Symbols**: flags representing power and ownership. Australian native plant showcasing new specimens.

Setting: view of Sydney Harbour. **Shape**: curved shapes representing the natural environment. Line: curved lines suggesting movement of the sails. Vertical lines of the water enhance the calmness of the image. Vector or reading path: the Aboriginal person seems to be looking at the ship. The plants lead the eye towards the additional ships and town. The Aboriginal people on the right lead the viewer to their activity. South Wales. 1822. in Soldenser at 1000


