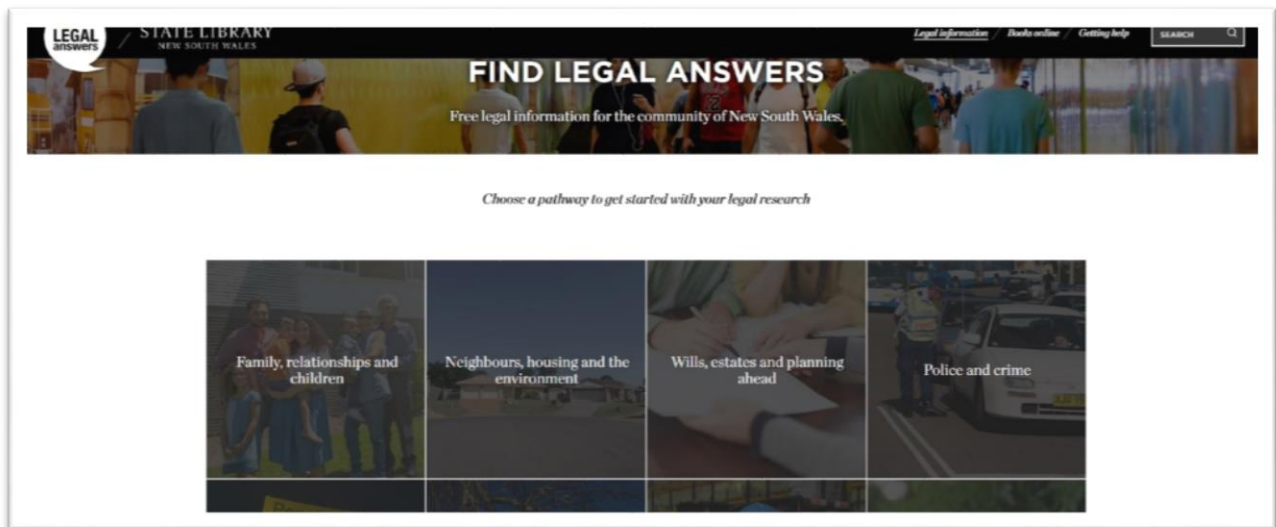


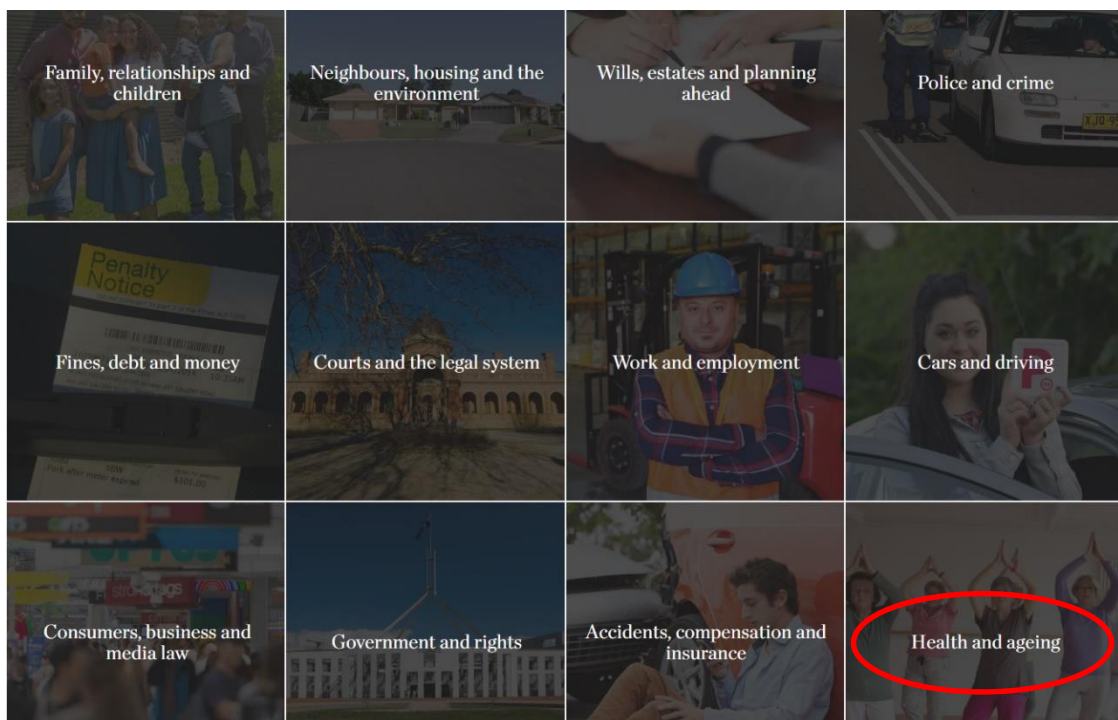

Seniors guide to consumer rights in NSW



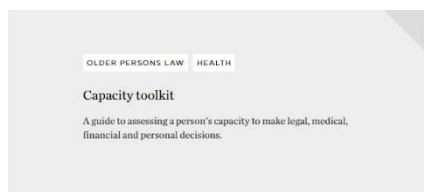
Information for seniors from NSW Fair Trading on shopping rights, avoiding scams, housing, building or renovating, buying and maintaining a car, and planning ahead.
