

First Fleet Headbands

- Choose one ship from the First Fleet and write its name on one of the paper strips.
- Research your ship. Colour in the picture above to show what kind of ship it was, using red for convict transport ships, blue for Navy escort ships and green for supply ships.
- On the headband (behind the picture, on the strip, or anywhere you can find room!), write down any information you can find out about your ship, for example, how many people sailed on this ship, who was in charge, or how many people died along the way.
- Cut out the two strips along the dotted lines and tape it to the size of your head.
- Cut out the ship picture and tape it onto the headband.
