Search tips for catalogue

- Use Advanced Search (see above) to combine more than one search term
- When searching for an author, enter surname first (eg. Flannery, Tim)
- Sign in to the catalogue to request material

Free to access with your State Library card: High quality, academic material to ensure your work is well-researched. Available online anywhere, anytime.

Important:

- Locate the subject HSC from the list on the left
- Open the '+' box next to HSC and tick Science for a list of recommended databases
- Or find a specific database by name (eg. Informit) in By database title

Search tips for eResources

- Use "quotation marks" for exact phrase searching
- Use ADVANCED search options to combine words using AND, OR, NOT

- Use asterisks * for wildcards alternative endings of words. Eg. astronom* = astronomy, astronomical, astronomer
- Select Full text search options to find full-text articles only
- Watch your spelling both for accuracy and American spelling variations
- Vary your search terms try synonyms for your topic words
- Refine your results in some databases by limiting to scholarly or peer reviewed sources, for academic level journals which have been evaluated by experts

• Provides online full-text access to a wide range of international journal articles and newspapers with some Australian content.

• Provides online full-text access to reference books, and some journal and magazine articles on current science topics. Includes images, videos and audio which can provide comprehensive coverage of a topic.

Informit

• Provides online full-text access (with some references only) to Australian scholarly journals.

JSTOR

• Provides online full-text access to historical and recent international science journals.
