Target age group: 3-5 yearsTheme: MoustachesDate:

Objectives for children's learning:

- New vocabulary "moustache"
- Expanded background knowledge about facial hair
- Thinking about time, waiting and quick / slow

Equipment and props:

- Song lyrics on easel
- Toy prop moustaches
- Pictures of famous moustaches (eg Salvador Dali, Groucho Marx, Santa Claus, The Lorax Mr Potato head, Papa Smurf, LEGO minifigs with moustaches)

Welcome song / activity:

 "Can't Wait to Celebrate" by Jim Gill from the album Irrational Anthem or "The More We Get Together"

Introducing the theme:

- Talk about hair that grows on heads and beards and moustaches.
- Look at pictures of some famous moustaches (eg Salvador Dali, Groucho Marx, Santa Claus, The Lorax Mr Potato head, Papa Smurf, LEGO minifigs with moustaches)
- Real moustaches take a long time to grow ... you need to wait like we had to wait in our song.

Songs and rhymes:

- Moustache song to the tune of My Bonnie Lies over the Ocean
- Do dragons have moustaches? Let's sing 5 Little Dragons (tune of 5 little ducks)
- While you are waiting time seems to go slowly, but when you're having fun time seems to go
 very quickly ... let's sing a song about slow and quick Let's sing the <u>Slow Fast Song</u>
- Open Shut Them
- I have ten little fingers

Books and stories:

- **Mustache Baby** by Bridget Heos and Joy Ang ... who has a baby at their house? Does your baby have a moustache? Billy has lots of different jobs ... what sort of jobs would you like to do?
- Mo's Mustache by Ben Clanton ... was his moustache real or pretend?
- Moosetache by Margie Palatini ... there are lots of new words like whiskers, stubble
- Felt board face with a variety of moustaches to try on

Craft / activity:

- Make a pretend moustache to wear (like a photo booth prop or on a bendy straw)
- Draw a moustache on a paper plate face

Finishing up:

- See You Later Alligator: Storytime Goodbye Song or
- It is Time to Say Goodbye To All My Friends: Storytime Goodbye Song
