

Activity 5: Collecting and representing data – Beach activities

- As a class, write a list of the activities people like to do at the beach.
- Each student decides on three favourite activities. Write up the responses on a class tally chart.
- Record the results as a column graph or pictograph. An example is provided.

Analysing data

Discuss the data represented in the graph:

- What is the class's favourite beach activity?
- What is the class's least favourite activity?
- Use the terms 'less than' and 'more than' to describe the class's beach activities, e.g "Our class likes boating more than fishing".
- What activities are the same as shown in the sources?
- What activities are different? How are they different?
