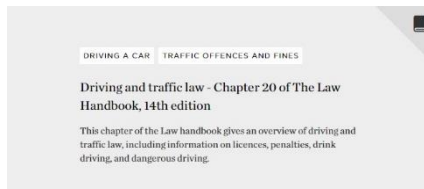
You will find online information including:

Crashed your car: information on claims for damage to your car, in and out of court



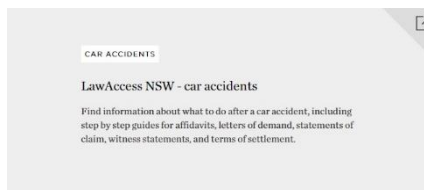
Information from Legal Aid NSW about what to do if you are involved in a car accident, including insurance, negotiating who will pay, and going to court.

Driving and traffic law chapter of the *Law handbook*



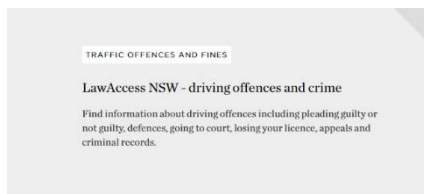
An overview of driving and traffic law, including information on licences, penalties, drink driving, and dangerous driving.

Information about what to do after a car accident, including step by step guides for affidavits, letters of demand, statements of claim, witness statements, and terms of settlement.

LawAccess NSW – Driving offences and crime



Information about driving offences including pleading guilty or not guilty, defences, going to court, losing your licence, appeals and criminal records.

Guilty your Honour: representing yourself in NSW Local Courts for drink driving



Helps defendants to drink driving charges prepare for court, including information about whether to plead guilty, whether to get a lawyer, preparing for court, and what happens on the day of court.
