### **Children and young people chapter of the Law handbook**



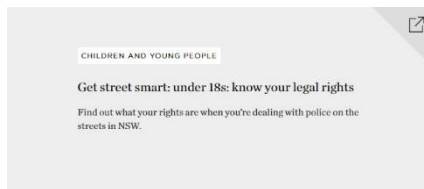
Covers criminal law, care and protection, adoption, and other legal issues including schooling and medical treatment.
